




What a fantastic day!


## Year 1 Memorable Experience

## Year 2 Memorable Experience

This half term Year 3 have been learning about forces in science. As part of their memorable experience, they visited Greenhead Park to carry out activities which involved investigating different forces in action.

We used the slide to test friction of different surfaces and how it affected the speed. We then walked around the park to see where else forces are in effect.





## Year 5 Memorable Experience

Year 5 put their map-reading skills into practise when they went orienteering in Beaumont Park. The children enjoyed using the compasses, planning their routes, and reading their maps. It was a great memorable experience.



## Year 6 Memorable Experience

Year 6 have been learning about the circulatory system in science. For our memorable experience, we were able to dissect sheep's hearts! Some children were grossed out: others enjoyed cutting open and finding the different features of the heart.
